#### Stone cornice

The cornice is a simple strip, which supports the gutter

.The main function is to discharge rainwater away from the facade





#### l eaked

Hole in the wall so that the pigeons can nest.





#### Bow in brace

Element of architecture in stone or wood.

The brace is formed by two opposite curvatures (curved and counter-curved).

#### Pediment

Architectural ornament which is usually made in a triangle and which is placed at the top of the main entrance of a building, above the doors.





Dry stone masonry is a construction technique consisting of assembling, without any motar binder (cement, lime...), stones to mount a wall.

How many stones compose the frame?








Jog on to the n°6.


Along the wall that goes to the town hall. The stone opposite is found in the wall.


Find it and note the inscriptions.







